### HOW TO GET TO US

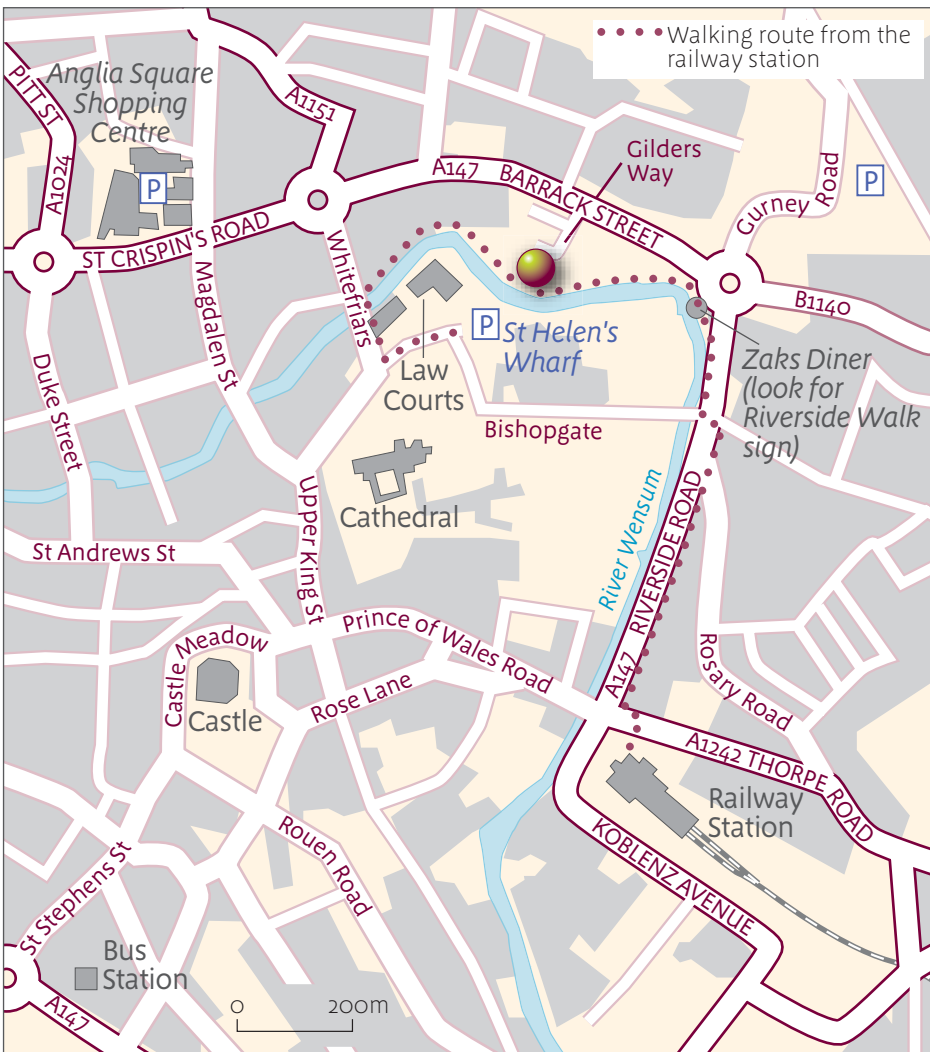
#### By public transport

Norwich railway station is a 15minute walk from the office via the route shown on the map.

#### By car

Visitors can park at the front of the building (in the visitor bays) for a maximum of 2 hours. Please note that wheel clamping is in force at Dragonfly House and a £75 charge will have to be paid in order for the vehicle to be released – this has been imposed by the Landlord (Jarrolds).

Visitors should notify reception that they have arrived by car and give their vehicle registration – in return, the visitor will receive a permit allowing them to stay for 2 hours.

If the visitor bays are full, then alternative parking will need to be sought. St Helen's Wharf car park, off Bishopgate, is the nearest to the office, or Anglia Square car park, which charges £5/day.

This does not apply to the 3 disabled parking spaces (blue badges must be displayed).

Cycle racks are available in the undercroft at Dragonfly House.
